

Rainbow Word Challenge



We are very excited to share with you our 'Rainbow Word Challenge' - a rewarding way of learning high frequency and tricky words.

What are High Frequency Words?

High frequency words are common words, words that appear very often in written texts. They are a mixture of <u>decodable words</u> (words that can be sounded out) and <u>tricky/exception words</u> (words in which the English spelling code works in an unusual or uncommon way, which means the words have to be learned and recognised by sight).

Why do we need to learn them?

It is important that children learn how to read these words by sight, as they will make up a large proportion of the words they will be reading in everyday texts. Once they have mastered reading them, they will also need to learn to spell these words.

How does the Rainbow Word Challenge work?

As you know, rainbows are made up of 7 colours! For each colour, we have designed a set of words for the children to practise at home and school. We explicitly teach tricky words in class, noting which parts of the words can be sounded out and which parts can't. We encourage the children to read these words by sight. When they are secure in recognising them in multiple of contexts, we assess them in school. On mastering one coloured set of words, the children move on to the next set and continue to work through the rainbow of colours. To celebrate their success, the children receive a certificate for all their hard work and a little surprise.

On completing reading the 7 sets, the children will go on to practise spelling their tricky words. Some children may even get on to the 'Over The Rainbow' words which are a combination of Phase 5 High Frequency Words and Year 1 Common Exception Words.


How can you help at home?
