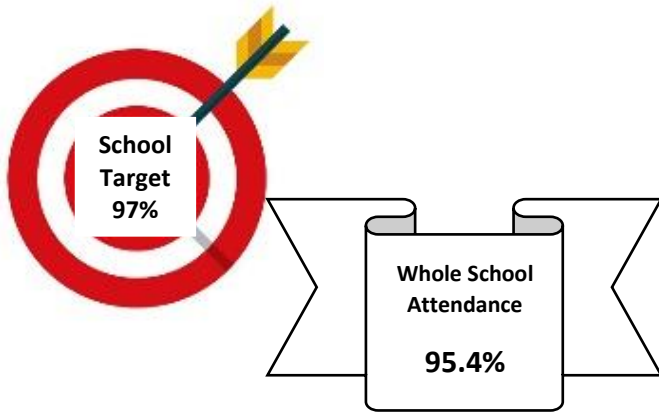

At Springdale First School we take attendance and punctuality very seriously. We aim to have an attendance figure above the national average of 96.7%. Attendance data is tracked by the Department for Education and will adversely affect our Ofsted rating if it is below the required level. Our current attendance percentage is 95.4% and we MUST improve on this figure. We categorise levels of attendance into **red**, **amber** and **green**.

GREEN - 100%. Excellent attendance above the national expected average, ideally where all children should aim to be.

AMBER - 96.7% or above. Good attendance - in line with or above national expected average.

RED - below 96.7%. Attendance below expected level. We will monitor the child's attendance and if we do not see an improvement, we will contact you by letter.

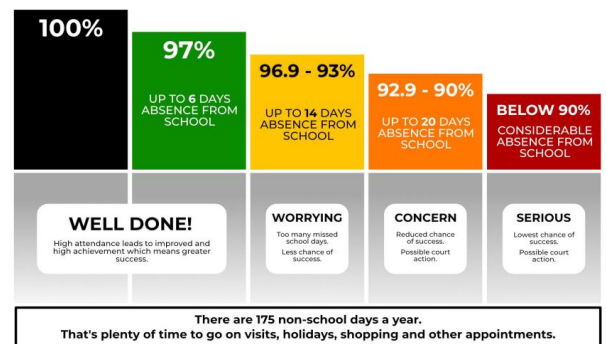
Request for leave of absence in term time due to exceptional circumstances.
