

## Maths

This term, Year 2 will start looking at multiplication and understanding what 'x' means. We will also come back to mental methods for adding and subtracting using our crossing 10 method to cross any multiple of 10.

Students will also begin to look at money, identifying different notes and coins and how to make amounts in different ways.

## History

We will continue focusing on the Georgian period as this was seen as the Golden Age of Piracy. Children will learn about the local history of pirates and smugglers, including their motivations for doing such things.



## Geography

After looking at the different countries of the UK, we will now start to look closer to home at what makes a rural and urban settlement. This will also involve a fieldwork trip to Broadstone High Street to survey people and collect data.

## English

In English, we continue to learn about adding suffixes, focusing on the when a word ends in 'y' (our change rule). We will also focus on compound words (toothbrush etc).

Children will also be encouraged to expand upon the conjunctions they use (when, if, that, because) and use these to add more detail to their writing.

Finally, students will learn about the progressive form of verbs (jumping, running etc.)

## Science

In Science, we will go on 2 different learning journeys. We will look at animals and plants.

### Animals

We will learn about different groups of animals, what animals need to survive, and how they are suited to their habitat.

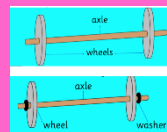
### Plants

## DT

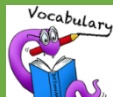
This term in DT, we will look at vehicles. We will learn the different elements of wheels, including the axles and chassis and then design and build our own moving vehicle.
