This week we learnt the following with a grown-up...

- * To 1:1 count objects to find out 'how many' objects there are altogether
- * To understand the last number in the count tells us 'how many' things there are altogether in a set of objects
- * To deepen their understanding of 5 as a quantity by linking the number itself to the 5 fingers on one hand.
- * To identify similarities in shapes
- * To hear, read and blend the following graphemes: \mathbf{j} (as in jam) \mathbf{v} (as in van) \mathbf{w} (as in wind) \mathbf{x} (as in fix)
- * Read and write cvc words and words ending in -s eg j-e-t-s v-a-n-s w-i-g-s f-o-x *To read the tricky word -into


- *To know that everyone celebrates different things
