



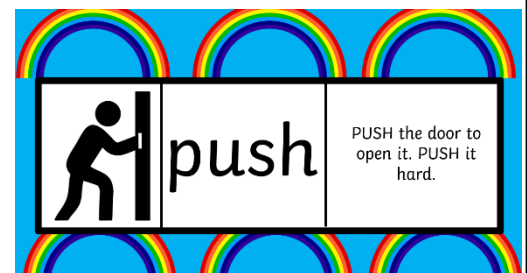
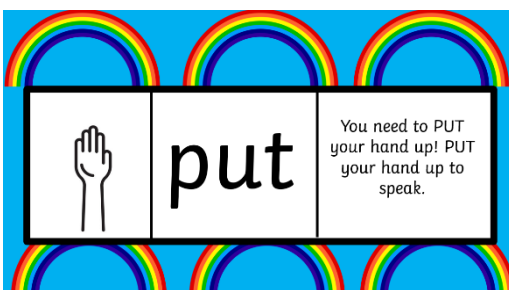
LEARNING NEWS



This week we learnt the following with a grown-up...

- * To compare two sets, noticing similarities and differences
- * To focus on ordinality – considering where numbers to 8 are in relation to each other
- * To hear, understand and use the language of ‘more than’, ‘less than’ and ‘equal to’. This week ‘less than’ is used instead of ‘fewer than’ when the focus is on each number’s position in the counting sequence
- * To compare items by height using language of short, shorter, shortest, tall, taller, tallest
- * To revisit the phoneme ng (as in ring) and nk (as in sink) and practise reading and writing them in CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) and CVCC (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant) words
- Eg. sing thing spring morning pink think drink
- * To read the tricky word – put and push
- * To understand the term ‘county’ and know that England is split into parts called counties
- * To know that we live in the county of Dorset and that Poole is part of Dorset
- * To explore landmarks of Dorset – Corfe Castle, the Jurassic Coast including Durdle Door and Lulworth Cove
- * In Drawing Club, we learnt the terms – ambush, accident, slinking, boulder and patient to develop our vocabulary surrounding the animation ‘Road Runner’
