### **This week we learnt the following with a grown-up...**

- \* To consolidate our understanding of the composition of numbers up to 7.
- \* To compose and de-compose numbers using part-part-whole relations, e.g. seeing that 7 can be made of 5 and 2
- \* To recognise that numbers can be made by combining parts in different ways
- \* To partition 7 (splitting it into parts) and thinking about the missing part.
- \* To revisit the phoneme ai (as in rain) and ee (as in seed) and practise reading and writing them in CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) and CVCC (consonant, vowel, consonant, consonant) words  
Eg. pain chain train seed cheek sweet
- \* There are 5 vowels a, e, i, o, u and we need to know these to help us with our spelling rules later on
- \* To read the tricky word – so and pull
- \* To use non-fiction texts to find out new information and vocabulary
- \* To recall our knowledge on Dorset and learn that it is home to the Jurassic Coast, which is famous for being a site to find fossils
- \* How fossils are made and what they can tell us
